### **Tools for the Job**

We provide equipment, tools, and uniforms that our clients cannot afford but that they need in order to be employed. This is the program that At Home Group was founded on and is also our largest program.



### **Your Own Business**

This program provides entrepreneurial opportunities to our clients. Clients come to us with an idea, they create a business plan and budget, and we help with training and start-up purchasing for small businesses.

### **Women in Medicine**



This program helps women who want to become employed in the medical field. We can help with certification fees, education and required uniforms, as long as they are related to employment in the medical field.

### **Education**

At Home provides scholarships for vocational education or job training programs. Applicants to this program are trying to increase their earning capacity through education, but have come up short of meeting the expense.
